

## Constitution of India Art 153 - Governors of States

**There shall be a Governor for each State:**

**Provided that nothing in this article shall prevent the appointment of the same person as Governor for two or more States.**

### SYNOPSIS

**Office of Governor:** The Governor has a dual role. The first is that of a constitutional head of the state, bound by the advice of his Council of Ministers. The second role is to function as a vital link between the Union Government and the State Government, B.P. Singhal v. Union of India, (2010) 6 SCC 331.
