

Constitution of India Art 2 - Admission or establishment of new States

Parliament may by law admit into the Union, or establish, new States on such terms and conditions as it thinks fit.

NOTES

Nature & Scope: Article 2 gives a wide latitude in the matter of prescription of terms and conditions subject to which a new territory is admitted.¹
