

Kalimat

The Six Kalimat are the basic beliefs of Muslims all around the world. They practice these beliefs and incorporate the basic principles in their lives.

1. First Kalima: Tayyab (Purity)

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ مُحَمَّدٌ رَّسُولُ اللَّهِ ط

There is no God but Allah, Muhammad is the messenger of Allah.

2. Second Kalima: Shahadat (Testimony)

أَشْهَدُ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ وَأَشْهَدُ أَنَّ مُحَمَّدًا عَبْدُهُ وَرَسُولُهُ ط

I bear witness that no-one is worthy of worship but Allah, the One alone, without partner, and I bear witness that Muhammad is His servant and Messenger.

3. Third Kalima: Tamjeed (Glorification)

سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ وَالْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ وَلَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَاللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ ط وَلَا حَوْلَ وَلَا قُوَّةَ إِلَّا بِاللَّهِ الْعَلِيِّ الْعَظِيمِ ط

Glory be to Allah and Praise to Allah, and there is no God but Allah, and Allah is the Greatest. And there is no Might or Power except with Allah.

4. Fourth Kalima: Tauheed (Unity)

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ يُحْيِي
وَيُمِيتُ وَهُوَ حَيٌّ لَا يَمُوتُ أَبَدًا أَبَدًا ط ذُو الْجَلَالِ وَالْإِكْرَامِ ط
بِيَدِهِ الْخَيْرُ ط وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ ط

(There is) none worthy of worship except Allah. He is only One.
(There is) no partners for Him. For Him (is) the kingdom. And
for Through Him (is) the Praise. He gives life and causes death.
And He (is) Alive. He will not die, never, ever. Possessor of
Majesty and Reverence. In His hand (is) the goodness. And He
(is) the goodness. And He (is) on everything powerful.

5. Fifth Kalima: Astaghfar (Penitence)

أَسْتَغْفِرُ اللَّهَ رَبِّي مِنْ كُلِّ ذَنْبٍ أَذْنَبْتُهُ عَمَدًا أَوْ خَطَا سِرًّا أَوْ
عَلَانِيَةً وَأَتُوبُ إِلَيْهِ مِنَ الذَّنْبِ الَّذِي أَعْلَمُ وَمِنَ الذَّنْبِ الَّذِي
لَا أَعْلَمُ إِنَّكَ أَنْتَ عَلَّامُ الْغُيُوبِ وَسِتَّارُ الْعُيُوبِ وَغَفَّارُ
الذُّنُوبِ وَلَا حَوْلَ وَلَا قُوَّةَ إِلَّا بِاللَّهِ الْعَلِيِّ الْعَظِيمِ ط

I seek forgiveness from Allah, my lord, from every sin I
committed knowingly or unknowingly, secretly or openly, and I
turn towards Him from the sin that I know and from the sin that I
do not know. Certainly You, You (are) the knower of the hidden
things and the Concealer (of) the mistakes and the Forgiver (of)
the sins. And (there is) no power and no strength except from
Allah, the Most High, the Most Great.

6. Sixth Kalima: Radde Kufr (Rejecting Disbelief)

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ أَنْ أَشْرِكَ بِكَ شَيْئًا وَأَنَا أَعْلَمُ بِهِ
وَأَسْتَغْفِرُكَ لِمَا لَا أَعْلَمُ بِهِ تُبْتُ عَنْهُ وَتَبَرَّأْتُ مِنَ الْكُفْرِ
وَالشِّرْكِ وَالْكَذِبِ وَالْغَيْبَةِ وَالْبِدْعَةِ وَالنَّمِيمَةِ وَالْفَوَاحِشِ
وَالْبُهْتَانِ وَالْمَعَاصِي كُلِّهَا وَأَسْلَمْتُ وَأَقُولُ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ
مُحَمَّدٌ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ ط

O Allah! Certainly I seek protection with You from, that I associate partner with You anything and I know it. And I seek forgiveness from You for that I do not know it.
